## Ordering Options (Deadline: April 14, 2022):

- 1) **Online** at [www.ETICKETHAWAII.COM](http://www.ETICKETHAWAII.COM). Click on the “2022 BW MVB Tourney” link and follow the instructions for ordering your tickets online. If you do not currently have an etickethawaii.com login, you will need the customer # and pin # information listed above login to your season ticket account.
- 2) **In Person** payments can be made at the Stan Sheriff Center Ticket Office with Visa, MasterCard, Discover Card, JTB, or Cash. The Stan Sheriff Center Ticket Office is open Mon - Fri 9:00 am – 5:00 pm. Closed on State Holidays.

## Other Important Information

- **Tickets will not be mailed to you.** Purchased Mobile Delivery tickets will be available in your etickethawaii.com season ticket “My Account” by **Mon, April 18**. Will-call ticket pick-up begins on **Mon, April 18, @ 11:00 a.m.** and continues during normal business hours (M-F 9:00 am – 5:00 pm).
- For will call pick-up, please present a picture I.D. when picking up your tickets. If you are having someone else pick up your tickets, please write and sign a letter authorizing them to do so and have them bring the letter with them for pick-up (along with their picture I.D.).
- With the short turnaround time, requests for changing seats or purchasing additional seats will not be granted. However, additional packages for the tournament can be purchased on **Mon, April 11, @ 9:00 a.m.**
- Individual tickets will go on sale **Thurs, April 21, 2022 at 9:00 a.m.**
- If you purchased a regular season parking pass, unfortunately, it is **not valid** for post-season events. Parking will be \$7.00 each day.

## SimpliFi Arena at Stan Sheriff Center - Game Day Information

- LumiSight health check is no longer required.
